As a member of the Parents' Council, your knowledge and experience will help shape and monitor the District's efforts to improve special education.

*The Modified Consent Decree (formerly the **Chanda Smith** Consent Decree) has established the Parents' Council which will advise the Independent Monitor on issues relevant to families of children who are eligible to receive Special Education services from LAUSD. Some of the Parents' Council responsibilities include:

- Review the District's implementation of the Modified Consent Decree.
- Periodically meet with representatives from the Independent Monitor, District and Counsel for the Plaintiffs to discuss issues regarding the implementation of the Modified Consent Decree.

The Council meets every second Monday of the month from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Moseley-Salvatori Conference Center next to Good Samaritan Hospital, in downtown Los Angeles. Transportation, child care and interpreters are available.
